Surrounded by the magnificent mountains, coastline and bushland of the Freycinet Peninsula, Saffire Freycinet is nestled in the heart of east coast Tasmania's most spectacular landscapes. From the moment of arrival, the iconic stingray-shaped building evokes a seamless connection to the sea and surrounding environment. Activities for nature enthusiasts abound, from birdwatching on guided coastal walks to tasting honey fresh from the hive and up-close encounters with the endangered Tasmanian devils that live onsite. This is Saffire Freycinet for nature lovers.



THREE NIGHT ITINERARY



DAY 1

ARRIVAL AND WELCOME

As you arrive at Saffire Freycinet, you'll be awestruck by the majestic views of The Hazards mountain range and Great Oyster Bay. Kick back with a welcome glass of Tasmanian sparkling and notice how your surroundings are subtly connected to nature: the way the building's flowing organic form embodies the ocean; the Huon pine stumps doubling as coffee tables; and the abundant natural light pouring through the floor-to-ceiling windows that frame the breathtaking vista. When you're ready, a Saffire guest services manager will show you to your suite and leave you to settle in.

AFTERNOON

This afternoon is yours to do with as you please. Take the time to explore your suite and notice the design touches that are a deliberate nod to Freycinet's rugged coastal landscape: the use of Tasmanian timber, stone, and leather; custom rugs that depict the local flora and fauna; and a colour palette that reflects the pink granite of the peninsula, its white sandy beaches, sapphire-blue waters and the muted green of the native bushland.



Take a stroll down to Muirs Beach to get the lay of the land. Wander along this two-kilometre-long stretch of sand, keeping an eye out for marine treasures washed up on the shore: thick strands of kelp; the clear, crescent-shaped egg sacs of sand snails; and the shells of abalone and scallops.

Upon returning to your suite, pour yourself a drink from the well-stocked minibar featuring Tasmanian wines, spirits, and craft beers, and sit outside on your private deck to watch native birds or perhaps a relaxed potoroo in the coastal vegetation that surrounds your suite.



DAY 1

16:30 - 18:00

Signature experience: Tasmanian Devils

It's time to come face to face with Tasmania's most iconic animal: the Tasmanian Devil, a carnivorous native marsupial. Saffire Freycinet has created a one-hectare, free-range enclosure – a retirement home, of sorts – to accommodate mature devils that have been part of the state's breeding program. Meet your guide and take the short walk up to the onsite enclosure, ready for your up-close and personal encounter with these remarkable creatures. Meet the resident devils and observe them as they feed and interact. Your knowledgeable guide will share fascinating insights into the lives and behaviours of these animals, and explain how the Tasmanian Devil is, unfortunately, facing the threat of extinction due to a contagious facial tumour disease. Conservation efforts are crucial, and by partaking in this experience, you are actively contributing to the survival of this incredible species.

EVENING

Join us for dinner at your leisure at Palate Restaurant, which is open exclusively to guests and has a reputation as one of Australia's most revered fine dining restaurants. Daily multi-course tasting menus matched with outstanding local wines are designed around the very best produce available; think plump oysters and mussels from

the region's pristine waters paired with a crisp Tasmanian riesling, or the best of Tasmania's succulent grass-fed beef with a glass of juicy local pinot noir.

Once seated at your table, take a moment to admire the views of Great Oyster Bay and The Hazards mountains through the floor-to-ceiling windows, then let Palate's expert team guide you through the evening's tasting menu, or create your own à la carte culinary journey. Most wine and beverages are included.



After dinner, return to your suite, grab a blanket (and a nip of one of Tasmania's famous single-malt whiskies from your minibar) and head down to Muirs Beach. It's the perfect setting to lie back on a blanket and admire the dazzling display of constellations. If you're lucky, you may even get to witness the breathtaking sight of the Aurora Australis or Southern Lights, which can sometimes be seen in the Freycinet area.



DAY 2

MORNING

Opt for an alfresco breakfast this morning, with your preferred menu to be packaged up picnic-style and delivered to your room. Take it down to Muirs Beach, along with a picnic rug, and enjoy a leisurely breakfast with your toes in the sand to a soundtrack of lapping waves. Tip: turn right as you step onto the beach for a picture-perfect sheltered picnic spot framed by vibrant orange rocks, white sand and blue water. After breakfast, take a morning stroll along the shores of Great Oyster Bay.

10:00 – 12:00

Signature experience: Beekeeping

Experience the wonder of Tasmanian nature at its most raw, captivating, and sweet. Tasmanian honey production is on the rise, with some local apiaries drawing international attention for their decadent and golden produce. This honey forms part of an unforgettable culinary encounter at Saffire, where you'll learn the secrets behind the sweetness which draws inspiration from the



surrounding environment. Don a full-body apiarist suit and venture into the onsite Saffire apiary. Under the safe guidance of Saffire Horticulturalist, Rob 'The Bee Man' Barker, you'll experience the thrill of extracting and tasting fresh honeycomb, and witness the breathtaking natural phenomenon of honey being made in front of your eyes by Tasmanian bees.



DAY 2

AFTERNOON

Lunch is served at your leisure in the lounge. A more relaxed affair than dinner; join us for a seasonal spread of Tasmania's finest produce, complemented by an à la carte option from land and sea.

14:00 – 16:30

Signature experience: Wineglass Bay Lookout Walk

Lace up your comfortable shoes and meet your Saffire guide, who'll transfer you to the start point of the famous Wineglass Bay Lookout Walk. Beginning at the entrance to Freycinet National Park, this moderate trail is suitable for most fitness levels, despite its steep ascent, and can be enjoyed at your own pace. Along the way, you'll be treated to panoramic views of the pristine coastline, rugged cliffs, and lush forests as you breathe in the pure Tasmanian air. With each step, the mesmerising beauty of Wineglass Bay unveils itself; the turquoise waters glisten under the sun, while the pure white sand forms a perfect crescent, resembling a delicate wineglass. The view is breathtaking, offering a moment of serenity and wonder that will stay with you forever. There's a good chance you'll spot native

birds and wildlife like white-bellied sea eagles, scarlet robins and yellow-tailed black cockatoos, along with wallabies, echidnas and wombats.

EVENING

Choose a field guidebook from the library and settle into the lounge with an aperitif in hand, checking off the bird, plant and wildlife species spotted on this afternoon's walk. Enjoy sunset canapés before heading into dinner at Palate Restaurant at your leisure, followed by a restful night's sleep.





DAY 3

MORNING


Join us for breakfast at Palate Restaurant at your leisure.

09:30 – 12:00

Signature experience: Connection to Country

Take in the beguiling beauty of the bay and peninsula with this insightful walking tour hosted by local First Nations guide Mick Quilliam. Walk in the footsteps of the Oyster Bay tribe, who traversed and gathered over the land between what we now know as Schouten Island to Moulting Lagoon. Marvel at the beauty of the coastal tracks and rock platforms, and the wonders of the flora and fauna that thrive in this astonishingly untouched landscape, of which Saffire Freycinet is now a part. Sample the local bush tucker which grows all around you and learn first-hand from Mick about tools and foraging techniques used by the area's Traditional Owners. This exploration fosters a sense of appreciation for the land and its resources.





DAY 3

AFTERNOON

Lunch is served at your leisure in the lounge.

14:00 – 16:00

Signature experience: Freycinet Bay and Capes Walk

Join your guide for an afternoon surrounded by nature, combining two of the popular shorter walks of Freycinet Peninsula – Cape Tourville and Sleepy Bay. Take a pair of binoculars with you; you're bound to spot some interesting birds and wildlife today. Your first walk will be around the Cape Tourville Lighthouse with stunning views of the Tasman Sea as well as glimpses of Wineglass Bay. During this easy stroll you will learn about the abundant sea life below as well as the plant communities found within the national park. The second walk is to Sleepy Bay, where you will descend gently graded steps to the rocky shoreline while learning about the geology and how The Hazards mountain range was formed. Ask your guide to help identify nesting shorebirds like hooded plovers, pied oyster catchers and fairy terns for your species checklist.



EVENING

Kick off with sunset canapés in the lounge, where you'll have the chance to meet and mingle with the property's guest services managers. Head into Palate Restaurant for dinner at your leisure.



DAY 4

MORNING

Enjoy a final sunrise from the comfort of your cosy bed, with a tea or coffee in hand. Take a leisurely breakfast at Palate Restaurant in your own time. Your luggage will be collected from your room and stored until you return from the cruise.

09:00 – 12:30

Touring experience: Wildlife & Wilderness Cruise

Discover the best of the Freycinet Peninsula onboard our Wildlife & Wilderness Cruise. This half-day experience on Saffire Freycinet's private vessel is the ultimate way to explore the Freycinet National Park, with a thrilling journey past everchanging scenery featuring craggy granite sea cliffs and caves, quiet coves fringed by powdery white-sand beaches, remote rocky islands and the vast rugged mountains towering in the backdrop.

This is not a cruise to get from A to B; it's a journey packed with moments that will take your breath away.

Prepare for close-up interactions with marine mammals including playful dolphins and inquisitive fur seals whose colonies thrive on the rugged shores of the National Park's islands. Majestic seabirds like white-bellied sea eagles and albatross can often be spotted soaring in the skies above or nesting in the treetops. You may be lucky enough to witness the sight of graceful bull rays cruising through the clear waters, or in winter and spring, humpback whales on their annual migration.

Whether you're a nature enthusiast, a wildlife lover, or simply seeking an adventure in one of the world's most spectacular locations, our Wildlife & Wilderness Cruise is an experience that will stay with you forever.
